Los The Pfeiffer's presents us with a dystopic scenario, an imaginary future era, in which music as we know it today has disappeared, art is dying, the digital era is becoming powerful, a consequence of current social trends extrapolated to apocalyptic ends; the machine takes control of human emotions.

The presence of technology in our time, and its malpractice, could lead humanity to a soulless future.

We gather information from the seventh art, from apocalyptic scenarios, from films such as Dune, Metropolis, Black Mirror,...

From books and authors such as George Orwell, "1984", Kurt Vonnegot with "The Pianola", where men are left behind by machines; among others.

Aesthetics is based on metaphysical painting and dehumanisation.

PFEIFFER: The origin of the word refers to the person who played the fife, which is a very high-pitched piccolo. Comes from the german "Pfeife", which comes from the latin word "pipare". A man playing a wind instrument can be seen on the noble coat of arms. An unhonourable or derogatory way of calling musicians.

Graduate in Art History from the University of Salamanca. She has been working in the performing arts sector since 1999. Training in theatre, music and clowning with great masters such as Jesús Jara and Jordi Purtí.



Co-directs the Circus Theatre Company LA TROUPE MALABÓ from Betxí, Castellón, together with Sergio Chaves, as an actress, clown, artistic director, author and creator. This company has 20 years of professional experience and more than 30 productions.

Professional career since 2000, covering indoor theatre, street theatre, cinema, and circus as a clown, her forte and dedication in recent years, and for which she has been awarded as best circus artist by IVC in 2020 for "Sophie".

Also awarded as costume designer in 2021 as best costume by IVC (Valencian Institute of Culture) for "Karpaty".

SERGIO CHAVES (artistic and stage director)

Actor, director, producer and distributor since 1999 in the professional sector of the Performing Arts.

He co-directs the Circus Theatre Company La Troupe Malabó with Marisa Ibáñez, which he founded in 2000, with more than 20 years of experience and more than 30 productions. He trained as a clown with great professionals.

He has also worked in other companies in his beginnings: Scura Splats, Xarxa Tetare, Teatro de la Saca, Visitants.

Professional and formative trajectory covering street theatre, indoor theatre and circus as a clown, his forte and dedication in the Company. Audience award for the show Tres Payasos de Maleta in Fitcarrer 2002, with which they toured the Sahara in refugee camps. In charge of the artistic direction of several festivals in Castellón.

JOSEP SANCHO (musical director)

Penderecki Music Competition in Poland and one of the most active clarinettists of his generation.

He has performed as a soloist and chamber musician in Italy, Germany, England, Poland, Slovenia, Canada, Jordan, the United States and in the main cities of Spain.

Josep Sancho studied in Barcelona with Joan Enric Lluna and at the Royal Academy of Music in London, receiving advice from Angela Malsbury, Michael Collins, Thea King and Anthony Pay.

At the same time he has studied Philosophy at the Jaume I University in Castellón.


He holds a Master's degree in Music Performance and Research from the International University of Valencia.

He has won prizes at the JJ.MM de Espana (Madrid), Palau de la Música de Barcelona, the Geoffrey Hawkes Clarinet Prize in London, the John Ireland Chamber Music Competition and the BBC Young Artists Forum.

He has collaborated with numerous national and international orchestras.

He has frequently collaborated in 20th century music festivals.

He has recorded for national and international radio. He has given master classes in Spain and abroad.



He began his artistic career in 1992. He was trained as a clown with great with great professionals. Other techniques he has studied are: mime, street theatre, stilts, neutral mask, art comedy and improvisation match among others. He is backed up by 30 years of experience.

He has worked in different companies: ARENAL TEATRO, TEATRO DEL TRAPO, CÍA AÉREA, COMBINATS, PUNTO CLOWN, LA REPERA TEATRE, THE GORDO'S, AND LA TROUPE MALABO. Since 2006 he has been working as an intervention clown in hospitals for the NGO PAYASOSPITAL.

In 2018 he created his own professional company; CÍA. QUIQUE MONTOYA, highlighting his shows TORNILLO MAGIC CLOWN, TORNILLO GOLD EDITION and MANOLO PIÑO.

He has directed "ON ESTÁ MERCÈ" COMPAÑÍA BANDADA. (awarded as best show at Cabañal Íntim), "SINDY PEPA" HANNAH ALBA COMPANY, "LOS OTROS CUENTOS DE QUITA Y PON". ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE PLOT, "CACHIVACHES". CLOWNDESTINO TEATRO.

He has also participated in different television programmes as a comedian for Mediaset.



MARIA JOSÉ PUCHALT (violin)

Graduated in the speciality of Interpretation from the Superior Conservatory of Music of Valencia Joaquín Rodrigo.

She began classical dance at the age of 4, later complementing it with rhythmic gymnastics.

At the age of 9 he began studying violin with teachers such as Juan Manuel Ortega, Vicente Taroncher, Mirabai Weismehl, Marta Bazantova, Enrique Palomares, Vasko Vasilev and Vicente Balaguer.

From the very beginning he has combined his pedagogical work with his performing facet. She has been a member of the Chamber Orchestra of Mallorca, has participated as an orchestral musician in opera productions with Bizet's "Carmen" and Mozart's "Cossi fan tutte" and in musicals such as "The Phantom of the Opera" and "Les Miserables". She currently teaches at the Ateneu Cultural Ciutat de Manises.

LAURA AGÚSTI GONZÀLEZ (violin/soprano)



She holds a Higher Degree in Singing and a Higher Degree in Violin from the Conservatorio Superior de Música de Valencia (Valencia Conservatory of Music).

Likewise, the "High Certificate in Singing Mentoring" taken at The Vocal Center qualifies her as a vocal coach.

She is currently a teacher of lyrical and modern singing, specialising in musical theatre and jazz improvisation, as well as being a speaker on various vocal technique courses for public employees and teachers.

She has been training as an actress for more than ten years and has performed in various plays and performances. Her experience on stage is varied, performing as a solo singer, choir director, choralist, violinist and actress. She has also received training in clowning, body expression and dance.

She is currently immersed in several projects, as a singing actress in the musical "Main Street" by Sagitari Produccions.

She has participated in several soundtrack recordings.

SONIA TABARES (viola)



In 2006 she obtained her viola speciality degree under the tutelage of Francisco Emili Llopis i Agustí, professor at the Conservatorio Superior de Viola de Castellón and a reference in the community.

Her violin training was under the guidance of several renowned teachers. She was awarded several prizes as a soloist and in chamber music.

Founding member and viola soloist of the youth orchestra of Castelló, the string quartet of Castelló, Quinteto Fermata, awarded with an international first prize, and Enigma string quartet, as well as the symphony orchestra of Castellón, Castellón XXI under the baton of Josep Vicent, and the instrumental ensemble being viola soloist.

She furthered her training with a master's degree in pedagogy, musicology and music therapy. She has been a viola teacher since 1999 to the present day.

ALBERTO MUÑOZ VICENTE (cello)



In 2007, with the Prize of Honour, end of Professional Degree.

Subsequently in the Netherlands, he graduated in Higher Studies and completed a Master's degree in cello performance at Rotterdam University for the Arts. He studied further studies at the Zutphen Cello Academy. In 2009 he received a scholarship from Columbia University (NY) USA to study at the Fontainebleau American Conservatoire (France).

Master's degree in research at the Salvador Seguí Conservatory in Castellón (Spain). Member of The LSQ String Quartet, he won the Grotekamermuziekprijs van Nederlands (Grand Prize for Chamber Music in the Netherlands) and the Paolo Serrao Special Prize at the International Chamber Music Competition of the Citta di Filadelfia Italy in 2015.

Principal cellist of the Orchestra of the Philharmonic Society of Valencia, member and collaborator of numerous ensembles; Youth Orchestra of the Generalitat Valenciana, Codarts Symphony Orchesta, Rotterdam Camerata, National Youth Orchestra of Holland, Chamber Orchestra of the Valencian Community, ADDA, Orquesta Ciudad de Córdoba, Orquesta Reino de Aragón among others. At the age of 18 he made his debut as a soloist at the Palau de la Música de València and in the Netherlands.

He is currently part of the chamber duo ZKDUO, with which he has published his first album on the JSM Records label and has been a finalist in the International Competition Ciutat d'Elx 2022.

The Company is committed to shows with commitment, with very careful aesthetics, for the study of new languages, always establishing clown as the root of the Company.

From the hand of its Founder and Director Sergio Chaves, with a long and tireless training in the speciality of clown. Many of his teachers are renowned such as Jesús Jara, Lluna Albert, Sergio Claramunt, Jordi Purtí or Leo Bassi, among others. And its co-director Marisa Ibáñez, a graduate in History of Art, with a long career in indoor and street theatre. Since 2004 she shares with Sergio Chaves the direction of La Troupe Malabó and her training as a clown.

The Company, in turn, has striven to carry out educational work over the years, working to create new audiences.

Today, the Troupe Malabó has a solid structure of professionals, with which to grow in quality.

The Company runs several festivals: Bagatge, Street Theatre Festival, since 1999; Mac Moncofa, street theatre festival since 2018; Pernassos, indoor clown festival; Grau de Circ, Circus Festival since 2020 and a couple of editions of the Mostra de Artes Escénicas de Castellón, 2020 and 2022.
